

COLLECTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF SOLID WASTES

Section 1. No person, business or corporation shall collect, transport, remove or haul solid waste for hire within the exterior boundaries of the Leech Lake Indian Reservation without having a valid permit from the Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee as set forth herein.

Section 2. All solid waste collected, hauled, transported or removed from any premises, business or industry may be disposed of only at a solid waste disposal location within the exterior boundaries of the Leech Lake Reservation that has a valid permit from the Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee.

Section 3. All containers or vehicles used for the transportation or collection of solid waste shall be covered and leakproof.


Section 4. All loading and collection of solid wastes shall be performed in such a manner as to prevent spillage or leakage. In the event any waste is spilled or dropped during collection or transportation, the material spilled shall be picked and cleaned up by the transporter or collector.

Section 5. The Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee shall issue licenses for collecting and transporting solid waste for hire under the following terms:


- a) The completion and filing of an application for a transportation and collection license with the Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee;
- b) Submission of a route and area to be served by the applicant including a description of which solid waste disposal fill area applicant shall use for disposal of all collected solid waste. The Reservation Business Committee may in its discretion limit the number of licenses to any area of the Leech Lake Reservation;
- c) The applicant shall submit a schedule of charges for hauling of solid waste to the Reservation Business Committee for approval.
- d) The applicant shall submit a list of all vehicles to be used in its collection and hauling operation, including a description of each vehicle and its specifications. All vehicles used for collection and hauling permit on their windshield.
- e) The Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee shall set a license fee for collection and hauling of solid waste. Said fee shall be based upon the size of said collection route and number of vehicles collecting and hauling solid waste.
