Old Business


- a. CPR & First Aid Training – held at AICHO on July 28, 2017; there were five attendees; future training possible

 - Archie spoke briefly about the public meeting that was held in Mille Lacs regarding the MCT constitution; They will be having another public meeting at Black Bear Hotel and transportation will be provided for all MCT band members who live in Duluth to attend; it will take place in November 2017
 - Housing assistance – Band members are able to apply for MCT home loans. However, most of the band members come into the Duluth office looking for rental assistance (deposit and first month's rent); Archie said the band has not done rental assistance since 2012 due to the budget.
 - College Student assistance - Gayle said she talked to Penny about her son who is student at BSU; he drives around to interview elders and would like to know if he could gas assistance; he also requested a nice tape recorder for recording the interviews; We were told that he could talk to Lee Turney.
